

TOWN OF MADBURY
Septic and Leachfield Inspections

All Septic Systems and Leachfields installed in the Town of Madbury must be inspected by a town-approved engineer according to current Building Regulations. (Article V-A, Section 1; Paragraphs F and E—page B-5).

NOTE: Detailed procedures are outlined below. They must be followed in order to obtain a Certificate of Compliance. An engineer taken from the list of Approved Engineers will issue a Certificate of Compliance, which is separate from the State Inspection giving approval for operation. Both the State Approval and the Certificate of Compliance must be presented to the Building Inspector prior to the system's use.

PROCEDURE

An engineer whose name is on the approved list for the Town must be utilized in the inspection of all systems at the designated times. The engineer shall be required to inspect each system on two (2) occasions:

- 1) At the time the original ground is cleared of all debris and organic matter and is ready to receive clean fill for leachbed installation, and prior to fill and/or tank being put in place.
- 2) When the system leachbed and tank and/or pump(s) are in place, prior to covering.

BILLING

Engineers' fees will be billed by the TOWN OF MADBURY to the owner of record of the lot under inspection.
